Hospital Pharmacies in outbreak-affected and unaffected areas along with Community Pharmacies provide essential service to the Patients (In-Patient & Out-Patient) and Health Care team through the supply of Medicines and Pharmaceutical Care and also ensures the continuity of these Services.

The Shared Responsibilities of Hospital Pharmacists

- Ensuring adequate Storage and Supply of appropriate Stocks of relevant Medicines and other Medical Products & Devices to meet the demand, including Masks, Thermometers, Goggles and other necessary equipment and to ensure that these products are adequately supplied if not managed by the Hospital Pharmacy.
- Collaborating with other Health care Professionals in providing Patient Care and Support.
- Promoting Hospital Prevention and Infection Control.
- Informing and Counseling.
- Ensuring the responsible use of the Pharmaceutical Products supplied. For example, ensuring that Health care Professionals wear their Masks appropriately and know how to take them off Correctly to avoid Contamination.
- Pharmacovigilance and Monitoring Treatment Outcomes.
